Visit to Buckingham Palace Wednesday 20th September 2017

Coach Departs Amenbury Lane (opp. Car Park) at 10.45am
(Remember parking is unrestricted in Avenue Saint Nicholas and Kirkwick Avenue from 10.30am)

Today we visit Buckingham Palace in the company of a Blue Badge Guide who will be on hand to provide us with information about the 19 sumptuous State Apartments which we will be visiting.

Our day starts at St Paul's Cathedral where we will meet our guide and where we will have free time to have lunch in the crypt of the Cathedral or in one of the various eating establishments nearby. We then have a guided coach tour to the Palace where our visit commences at 2.45pm. During our visit we will be able to enjoy a recently opened special exhibition, Royal Gifts. This exhibition tells the story of the Queen's reign through a wide-ranging display of over 250 official gifts presented to Her Majesty during the past 65 years, including those from many world leaders.

At the end of our visit to the State Apartments you will have time for relaxation and refreshments (not included) in the Garden Café in the Palace's West Terrace. Also, this summer we will be able to walk through part of the Palace gardens and see the famous 19th Century lake. The State Apartments and gardens have wheelchair access, but please let Bob Robinson know if you will be bringing, or would like to borrow, a wheelchair as the Palace needs to know in advance.

Our memorable day finishes with an entertaining coach tour of royal palaces and birthplaces while our guide entertains us with stories of royal triumphs and scandals! After dropping off our guide, we will be heading home from London at around 6.30pm.
